In continuation of this office admission Notice No. UHF/Regr.(Acad)/4-15/2024/31863-985 dated 05.12.2024, read with the clauses 6.3.1 and 6.3.2 of the Chapter 6 of the Prospectus for admission to the Doctoral Programmes of the Academic Session 2024-25, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has been pleased to adopt the following scheme for the allotment of Sports and Co-Curricular Seats in the University:

Clause 6.3.1: Weightage of various activities (only applicable for the candidates being considered for sports and co-curricular activities seat)

1. Sports/Games

The recipients of the Arjuna Award will be awarded 34 points. For other candidates, marks will be allocated based on the level of competition and the position secured, as detailed in the following table:

Provisions:

- The last two academic sessions will be considered for the award of marks in case of admission to PhD degree programmes.
- The maximum points in one academic calendar will be 40 only.
- The best one of the certificates in terms of scores amongst the three categories (Sports/Games, Co-curricular Activities and NCC/NSS/ Bharat Scouts guides) in one academic calendar will be considered

- Two additional points shall be awarded for each additional event (amongst events listed at respective Sr Nos. 1 to 4 of Sports/Games and Co-Curricular activities respectively) for participation/position at international, national, interuniversity and zonal level up to a maximum of three events and total points to the maximum of 6 points in these additional events.
- One additional point shall be awarded for each additional event (amongst events listed at respective Sr No 5 and 6 of Sports/Games and Co-curricular activities) for participation/position at the state and the University level up to a maximum of 3 points in these additional events.
- In case of a tie of scores for the candidates, the preference shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance test, if it still persists then the preference shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying examination. If the tie still persists preference shall be given to the candidate elder in age.
- In case, any doubt regarding the certificates produced by the candidates, is raised, it will be decided by the Committee constituted by the Chairman of the admission committee and the candidate's admission will be cancelled if found guilty by Registrar
- In case of doubt about the participation of any candidate, a committee constituted by Chairman of admission committee can ask for a trial.
- The decision of the Selection Committee regarding admission will be final.
